

Hamlet Community Clean-up

Community Clean-up is a General Fund Program intended to provide and Fairfax County communities with a method to keep their subdivision properties clean and free of bulky debris not normally collected by their regular refuse collection service. Our 500+ homes in McLean Hamlet qualify for this type of bulk pick-up, and your board schedules a Clean-up every year. Due to limited funding and yearly demand, the Clean-ups are scheduled on a first come, first served basis, starting on the first Saturday in March through the third Saturday of October. Look for an email from MHCA for any scheduled pick-ups in McLean Hamlet.

The county will provide the necessary equipment and personnel at Falstaff Park on the pick up date to dispose of residents' large items.

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Items may ONLY be dropped off between 8am – 12 noon. Nothing may be deposited prior to 8am.
2. This program is intended to provide collection of the following: **furniture, lawn mowers** (with gas and oil removed), **tires** (limit FOUR, off rims.) In addition, the following must be separated for recycling: **washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, de-humidifiers** and **airconditioners**.
3. The following **WILL NOT** be collected: normal household refuse, brush, yard waste, rocks, bricks, concrete, stone, dirt, motor oil, car batteries, paint, roofing shingles, drywall, asbestos, glass, hazardous chemicals and pesticides, toxic waste, animal waste or explosives.
4. Other items may be subject to approval by the County.
